Job Title: Honorary Consul

Type: Fixed Term Contract for three years, with a probation period of one year

Location: Luanda, Angola

The Australian High Commission in Angola is seeking expressions of interest for an Honorary Consul position based in Luanda, Angola.



About the Position:

The Honorary Consul is appointed by the Australian Government to provide consular and passport services to Australian citizens in Angola and reports to the Australian High Commissioner in South Africa. The Honorary Consul also makes a contribution to the bilateral relationship between Australia and Angola.

It is mandatory that the candidate is fluent in English. If you make it through the selection process, the High Commission in South Africa will invite you for an interview and eligibility checks.

The role of an Honorary Consul is by definition honorary. It is not salaried and does not have pension entitlements. Potential candidates must be legal residents in the region of appointment. They must be in a position to provide suitable premises for the Consulate (more details can be provided upon request). Honorary Consuls receive an annual honorarium.

Applications must include a CV as well as a one-page cover letter detailing why you are suitable the role.
